

## EVENING OF INVITATIONAL SCENES AT 2012 FESTIVAL!

Dear Colleagues, Fellow Responders, Officers and Coordinators,

I am pleased to announce the birth of the Evening of Invitational Scenes to be presented for the first time during the 2012 Region VII Festival! While things are still in the creative process, please read this brief informational blurb and check out the new Invitational Scene section on the website before you leave town to respond!

Included on the normal production Respondent Form is a new category for "Associate Productions Only" entitled "Invitational Scene Consideration" which should be filled out for all Associate Productions, even if you do not feel the production/scene work should be put under consideration.

Remember as you debrief the nominated school's director of the potential of presenting a scene at the festival, that this is strictly a *nomination* to be considered and not a *confirmation* of an invitation to perform. It is vital that we stress this point, so there is no confusion when the scenes are chosen and subsequently invited.

If you can, find out if the school/production you wish to nominate would be willing and capable of bringing a scene to the festival before leaving the venue, and then check the box *Yes* or *No* when you respond on the form. This will save me hours of time in the fall!

And lastly, please be as specific as you can when filling out the form as to your description of the scene and the reasons why it should be invited. Specific comments about articulation, ensemble performance, diverse qualities, and entertainment value, etc. are much more helpful than "I really enjoyed it". What does this show have that maybe no one else can bring to our festival?
